Additional Information	 A basic DBS check will be required to commence volunteering. The cost will be covered by One YMCA. Two references are required as this role involves raising and handling money. The role is flexible and autonomous, but support will be provided as-and-when is needed and costs for resources or necessary equipment will be assessed on a needs-basis.
